In Holy Trinity College, we believe that the transition from Primary School to Post-Primary School should be as smooth as possible, to ensure that your son / daughter continues to work in an environment where he / she will feel safe, feel valued, feel nurtured and most importantly, feel happy.

### Additional Information:

- Holy Trinity College will build on the work carried out by your son / daughter's Primary school and receive a detailed profile of your child's ability and strengths in advance of their Induction into the College.
- A Summer Scheme in August 2026 will enable your son / daughter to become familiar with the College, build their confidence and get to know the pupils in their Form class.
- Specialised Nurture Provision in The Haven assists with transition to a large secondary school; prepares pupils for learning; develops social communication skills; and improves pupil wellbeing.
- The Learning Support Team will assist your son/daughter to develop at their own pace to access a broad and balanced curriculum via a range of supports in literacy, numeracy, mentoring, small group work, one-one support, organisational skills, friendship building and so on.
- A Learning Support Centre with specialist staff will support those pupils with moderate or severe learning difficulties. A Social Communication / Autism Centre is available.
- With a growing number of pupils diagnosed with Autism, the College established a Sensory Room in November 2022 to provide sanctuary from the outside world, and to enable pupils to feel calm, supported and focused.



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- Pupils in Years 8, 9 and 10 with a strong background in Irish language will complete their GCSE Irish Qualification at the end of Year 10.
- Year 8 pupils will have an opportunity to combine Technology with Engineering, thereby developing high quality skills for future career pathways.
- In June 2026, new Year 8 pupils will complete Cognitive Ability Tests (CAT) which provides the College, with further data to identify academic pathways for potential high achievers in Year 8, as well as identifying those requiring Literacy, Numeracy and Special Needs Intervention, from a specialist team of staff.
- Holy Trinity College aims to create an environment where every pupil from 11 – 18 years, can enjoy their education, achieve their academic potential, work at an optimum pace with appropriate support, stretch and challenge, aim high, and follow their career pathway to Third Level education and beyond.
- As a successful non-selective, all-ability and inclusive school, we look forward to working in partnership with our parents for seven years to deliver the best educational experience possible for your son / daughter.
- With our new school building offering 'state of the art' facilities we continue to build on subject delivery ensuring successful academic and applied outcomes, in addition to exceptional pastoral care. Providing a quality education will ensure our girls and boys are well equipped for society beyond school.
- Above all, we want pupils to be safe, valued, nurtured and happy, to enjoy coming to school every day and to be successful.

We hope you will be able to join us on our Welcome Open Day to see and hear about life in the College. Logging onto the College Website and Facebook platforms, also provides an update of activities and events which pupils experience on a daily basis.

Prior to Open Day, arrangements have been made with your child's Primary School for Primary 7 pupils to further experience a range of subjects and activities in the College via a **Subject Sampling Day, on Tuesday 20<sup>th</sup> January 2026**. This enhances our transition process to enable pupils to be familiar with the College before they enrol in September 2026.

- A '**Subject Sampling Day**' has been arranged for **Tuesday 20<sup>th</sup> January 2026**.
- Transport will be provided from the Primary School (if required) for arrival to Holy Trinity College.
- All pupils will have brunch in the College Canteen.
- Pupils are asked to wear their school uniform and suitable footwear for PE activities.
- Pupils will return to their Primary Schools by 1.30pm approximately.
- Subjects on offer include:  
Maths, ICT, Drama, PE, Home Economics, Technology/Engineering, Science, Irish, Music, Art, French, STEM, English, Religion, History, Geography
